Definitions

Amateur & Women- KTM Owners, will come through Zonal rounds.

PROs- KTM Owners, Top 20 finalists from RC Cup Season 1 (Top 3 winners excluded)/Anyone who has contested in any FMSCI accredited One Make Championship/Anyone who has raced in Indian National Road Racing Championship. Booking to open on 16th March on KTM India App exclusively. Limited slots for PROs

KTM Cup S2 – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. What is the KTM Cup?

KTM Cup is India's largest Racing Championship conducted by KTM India across three legs namely, Selection, Qualification & Finale. This is done under the aegis of FMSCI (Federation of Motor Sports Clubs of India)

2. How many categories?

Three categories- Amateur, Women, Pro's.

Amateur & Women- KTM Owners, will come through Selection rounds.

PROs- KTM Owners, Top 20 finalists from RC Cup Season 1 (Top 3 winners excluded)/Anyone who has contested in any FMSCI accredited One Make Championship/Anyone who has raced in Indian National Road Racing Championship. Booking to open on 16th March on KTM India App exclusively. Limited slots for PROs.

3. What will happen in zonal selection rounds?

Selection Round:

Race Academy & Selections for the Qualifiers basis the best lap time performance of individual rider- SUPERPOLE

Amateur

- Top 15 lap timing riders from each zonal round will qualify for the QUALIFIERS for One-Make Race (60 riders are chosen for qualifiers and from this 60, 15 will qualify for the finale races)
- Total 12 batches to happen in 1 Zonal round.

Women

- Top 6 lap timing riders from each zonal round will qualify for the QUALIFIERS for One-Make Race (24 riders are chosen for qualifiers and from this 25, 15 will qualify for the finale races)

PROs

- Top 40 eligible riders from will qualify directly for the QUALIFIERS(Level2) for One-Make Race (40 riders are chosen for qualifiers and from this 40, 15 will qualify for the finale races). They don't need to attend selection rounds. In case, they attend selection rounds, our training partners will move them to Pro's during qualifiers. All rules and regulations are binded by the decision of the training team – M/s. Gusto Racing India and the organizers.

4. Is there a CC wise category for races?

No. Only single category- 400 CC. This is a one-make race where all participants will race on KTM RC 390 GP.

5. Is this a single cup or 2 separate cups?

Single Cup- Single Championship

6. Is this a National Championship?

No - This is One Make Championship accredited by FMSCI. It has 3 rounds. Winners would be felicitated by KTM India & FMSCI.

7. Is the batch size restricted per race? If yes, what is the size?

All details would be available at the time of briefing.

8. Will I get a participation certificate?

Yes

Racer Registration, Eligibility-FAQs

1. Age criteria & eligibility?

Amateur & Women

KTM Owners, above 18 years of age with a valid Driving Licence. (For Amateur & Women)

PROs

1. Above 18 years of age with a valid Driving Licence. Top 20 finalists from RC Cup Season 1(Top 3 winners excluded)
2. Anyone who has contested in any FMSCI accredited One Make Championship in the last 3 years from the mentioned date(24th May 2024). **Result sheet mandatory to be furnished. Period: 24th May 2021 to 23rd May 2024.**
3. Only for KTM Owners.

2. Can I carry my own gear for the city selection round?

Yes, you can carry your own gear. However, it will have to be checked and approved by the training team before the start of the academy session.

3. What all the Enrolment fees includes?

- a. Bikes (KTM RC 390-Moto GP Edition) to be provided by KTM.

- b. Riding Gear except Helmet & Gloves (Jacket, Pants, Boots)- If selected at the time of registration.
4. Is KTM Cup S2 open to everyone?
No, it is exclusively for existing KTM(Duke/RC/Adventure/Husqvarna) owners. Proof of ownership mandatory. (Blood relationship to owner is allowed)
5. Is a valid FMSCI licence mandatory for Racing?
No, a valid Driving Licence is mandatory.
6. I have never ridden a motorcycle on track before. Am I eligible to participate?
Yes, If you are an owner of a KTM motorcycle.
7. Can i appear from different zones if I get disqualified in my previous rounds?
No, you are only eligible to apply from one of the 4 zones.
8. Do I need to bring my own bike for the races?
Not required. KTM will provide a KTM RC 390 GP for all participants.
9. Can I participate with my own bike if I choose to?
No. This is a one-make race series. For equal opportunity, all participants should be riding only the company provided KTM RC 390 GP.
10. How can I participate if I don't live in the city where selections are being held?
You can go to any of the above 4 cities that is closest to you.
11. What is the race academy? What will happen there?
The race academy will be a training session for all confirmed participants. These sessions will be conducted by professional racers. It will be a combination of classroom and practical sessions where you will be taught about all the nuances of track racing. Further our race mentors will give you feedback to help you improve your lap timings.
12. Whom should I contact in case of any queries?

Schedule

1. When would the registrations open?
25th Feb'2024.
2. What is the participation fee & Last date of successful payment?
INR 3000/-
Last Date: Bookings depending on slot availability.
3. Is the participation fee refundable?

Participation Fee is non-refundable.

4. Can someone else participate on behalf of a rider?

For Zonal Rounds, we can allow a rider to participate on someone else's behalf on furnishing a valid NOC certificate with signature of the original owner.

Please note that a rider who is not the actual owner of KTM motorcycle would only be eligible to participate in the zonal round. **If qualifies, he won't be able to participate in the Qualifying unless it's a blood relation case. (Supporting documents to be furnished in this case)**

5. Any orientation, the riders would go through?

A batch would go through a 2-hour session of Classroom & Track training.

Rider Selection

1. Any confirmation mailer to be received for rider selection which needs to be carried to the venue to participate in the race?

Post registration fee payment, you would get a confirmation email of your participation once the batch size completes.

2. Will KTM provide travel, stay, food during selection & main races?

All travel, food & stay arrangements to be done by the riders themselves. One-time snacks will be provided.

Price & Rewards, Motorcycle, Ride & Safety

1. One winner from each category (Amateur, Women & PRO) would get the below rewards:
 - a. Participation in KTM Academy of Speed. (<https://www.ktm.com/en-int/ktm-world/ktm-academy-of-speed.html>)
 - b. Train with KTM Experts.
 - c. An interactive session with KTM Ambassadors

2. Do I need to pay some fee for the motorcycle or do I need to pay money in case of some damage to the motorcycle.

No but if the training team feels that the damage has been done deliberately then the rider may attract the charges towards the repair of the motorcycle or a Ban for next Seasons.
